



 - Pathology of keel bone damage
 - Focus not only on high-energy collisions
 - Define different types of fractures, different causes
- Introduction round: contribution to WG3
 - 21 participants, ITC, industry, early stage researchers represented

Intervention strategies




- Housing and management: quite specific interventions proposed (light, perches, platforms, bird management) – ideas for STSMs and collaborations
- 2. Genetics: Need for good phenotype / genomic selection more knowledge needed on impact of KBD on bird
- 3. Nutrition: focus on early feeding, selenium, Omega-3/6, melatonin, link to bone and muscle physiology

Focus areas




- 1. Involvement of industry: leaflets for producers on bird management, transition from rear to lay, perch design
 - Palpation workshop relevant: distribute participation industry/ITC
- 2. ITC participation: in ITCs mainly birds in cages, no research KBD
 - Assess prevalence in various systems and present results to industry
 - Limited knowledge on KBD in cage systems (low impact damage)

Ideas for STSMs



- Rearing with and without perches (France), now in FC, trained assessor needed (before November 2017)
- Ramps and hybrids and how they effect KBD (previously submitted GP1) in Belgium
- Assessment fractures in quail (cages and aviaries) collect bones from various species in Slovakia

Ideas for training school



- Training school on management and housing at Vencomatic? Focus on housing and management innovations
 - Visit innovative systems (Antwerp/Eindhoven), experimental centre Geel, Hendrix Genetics Boxmeer
